Skills Canada Manitoba will once again be offering its annual Skilled Trades and Technology Showcase. Sign your students up early for what promises to be an exciting time for direct hands-on learning, career exploration and tons of fun!

What is the Skilled Trades and Technology Showcase?

A one day program for grade eight students, spent at a host school, where they have the opportunity to try hands-on activities and to learn about different careers in trade and technology. The showcase is designed to educate students on a variety of occupations and opportunities that exist in Manitoba in trades and technology. The day will be combination of hands-on learning, demonstrations and presentations from individuals working in different Manitoba industries. Some Showcases will include a presentation from "Safe Worker's of Tomorrow."

Who can participate?

This Program is geared for grade eight students, six per school (plus one chaperone), who are creative and dynamic. An excellent cross section of career areas are profiled, from architectural drafting to culinary arts, computer animation to carpentry. We suggest that students come from a variety of academic levels.
