NATIONAL COMPETITION ELIGIBILITY:

- A mark of **70% or higher** must be scored by the gold medalist in each contest in order for them to attend the National Skills Competition

Some stationary power tools and Electric Miter saws are available, but are limited in number, so good planning and time management are required.
