**CONTEST NAME:** Floristry

Bridal Bouquet

**EQUIPMENT, TOOLS, MATERIALS TO BE PROVIDED BY COMMITTEE:**

- Knife
- Pruning shears
- Scissors
- Glue gun and/or glue pan
- Hot and/or cold glue (non- aerosol only)
- Measuring tape
- Pins
- Green, brown or white corsage tape
- Waterproof tape (green or clear)
- Double-faced tape
- Wreath Wrap
- Wire – all gauges
- Wire – all decorative types
- Stapler and staples
- Water sprayer
- APRON IS MANDATORY

**EQUIPMENT, TOOLS, MATERIALS TO BE SUPPLIED BY COMPETITOR:**

Safety awareness/requirements will be maintained at industry (WBC or equivalent) standards at all times. A contestant will not be allowed to compete without proper safety equipment. Appropriate footwear is mandatory – no open toes or high heel shoes.

**WORKSITE SAFETY RULES / REQUIREMENTS:**

In case of a tie, judges will review and add the competitor's creative, mechanical and technical scores. The competitor with the highest score will be awarded the medal.
