COST

COMPETITORS

The cost of team travel (for competitors) to the Canadian Skills Competition being held in Charlottetown, May 19 - 23, 2009 is \$ 550.00. All competitors will be double/triple occupancy.

ADVISORS/DELEGATES

The cost of team travel (for advisors/delegates) to the Canadian Skills Competition being held in Charlottetown, May 19 - 23, 2009 is:

- \$1865.00 for single occupancy or
- \$1619.00 for double occupancy

NOTE: If double occupancy, please advise as to who you will be sharing with.

Please confirm your attendance by **Thursday, April 16, 2009**. Once confirmed, a cheque or purchase order is required by **Friday, April 24, 2009**.

Please note that all costs include airfare, transfers, hotel, registration fees, team building events and some meals.

Carry on

Each passenger is allowed two pieces (one standard and one personal, such as a laptop or a purse) of carry on luggage. Please ensure that it meets the following requirements:

Checked luggage

Each passenger is allowed two pieces of checked luggage. Please ensure that it meets the following requirements:

Maximum size

158 cm (62 inches)

(length + width + height)

Maximum weight

23 kg (50 lbs)

NOTE:

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE FEES FOR ANY LUGGAGE NOT MEETING THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS.

All tickets will be at the airport the morning of departure unless special arrangements have been made prior to travel. Tickets will remain in the possession of Skills Manitoba. Boarding passes will be issued to each passenger at time of check-in.

AIRPORT TRANSFERS

Arrival – Tuesday, May 19

Participants and delegates will register for the 15th Canadian Skills Competition at the Civic Center in Charlottetown. Capture the Spirit Tour Service busses will meet Team Manitoba at the airport and transfer all passengers to the Civic Centre to register and drop off tool boxes and then transport to the Rodd Royalty Inn & Suites.

Departure – Saturday, May 23

Capture the Spirit Tour Service will pick up Team Manitoba at the Rodd Royalty Inn & Suites at approximately 2:30 p.m. and transport the team to the airport.

HOTEL – RODD ROYALTY INN & SUITES (phone 902-894-8566)

Team Manitoba will be staying at the Rodd Royalty Inn & Suites. (Please see attached map.) A rooming list will be provided prior to May 19, 2009. Photo ID is required to check-in.

To the best of our ability we have accommodated all special requests. It is suggested that all advisors bring a copy of the rooming list so that they will know where their participants are staying.

REGISTRATION – TOOL BOXES

Participants and delegates will register for the 15th Canadian Skills Competition at the Civic Centre, immediately upon arrival in Charlottetown. Toolboxes will also be dropped off when registering.

Labels identifying competitor name, contest name, contest number and province must be on all toolboxes and will be available from Skills Manitoba upon arrival in Charlottetown.

At the end of the competition, all toolboxes must be taken off the floor and brought back to the hotel.

TEAM MEETING - MANDATORY

Team Manitoba will hold a **mandatory** breakfast on Wednesday, May 20, 2009 at 9:00 a.m. at the Rodd Royalty Inn & Suites in the Courtyard. At the Team meeting, team shirts will be distributed to all members. **Team shirts must be worn at the Opening and Closing Ceremonies.** Breakfast will be served at the team meeting.

TEAM EVENT - MANDATORY

Team Manitoba will host a **mandatory** team event on Wednesday, May 20, 2009 immediately following the team meeting. Team members will tour Charlottetown aboard tour busses.

CONTEST LOCATIONS

Contests will take place at both the Civic Centre and the Tourism & Culinary Institute. Please refer to the attached list of contest locations.

EVENT TRANSPORTATION

Shuttle Service May 18, 19, 20, 21, & 22, 2009

A shuttle service will be in place on May 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, between the Delta Hotel and the Tourism and Culinary Center and the Charlottetown Civic Center.

Evening Bus Service May 21 & 22, 2009

A bus service will be provided between the hours of 5pm and 9pm on the evenings of May 21 & 22, between the hotels and downtown Charlottetown and the Charlottetown Mall. On the evening of the 22nd the buses will also be routed to the restaurant areas of the city.

Opening Ceremonies May 20, 2009

Bus service will be provided from 4:00pm to 6:00pm from hotels/residences to the Confederation Center of the Arts.

Competitor Orientation May 20, 2009

Bus service will be provided from the Confederation Center of the Arts to the Tourism and Culinary Center and the Charlottetown Civic Center. Following orientation bus service will be provided from orientation sites to hotels/residence.

Closing Ceremonies May 23, 2009

Bus service will be provided commencing at 9:00am from hotels/residences to the closing ceremonies site at UPEI.

Competition Days May 21 & 22, 2009

From 4:30am to 9:15am bus service will be available from hotels/residences to the Tourism & Culinary Center and the Charlottetown Civic Center. From 3pm to 5pm bus service will be available from the competition sites to the hotels and residences.

OPENING CEREMONIES - MANDATORY

Opening Ceremonies will take place at the Confederation Centre of the Arts. Light snacks will be served at the Opening Reception prior to the opening ceremony.

CLOSING CEREMONIES - MANDATORY

Closing Ceremonies will take place at the University of PEI – CARI Complex. A light continental breakfast will be served prior to the closing ceremonies.

ELIGIBILITY – PROOF

It is important for you to travel with proof of age and proof of contest eligibility.

Eligibility would include a birth certificate or driver's license.

Eligibility for apprentices may include a letter from your Apprenticeship Counsellor determining that you are not a journeyman and your level of apprenticeship.

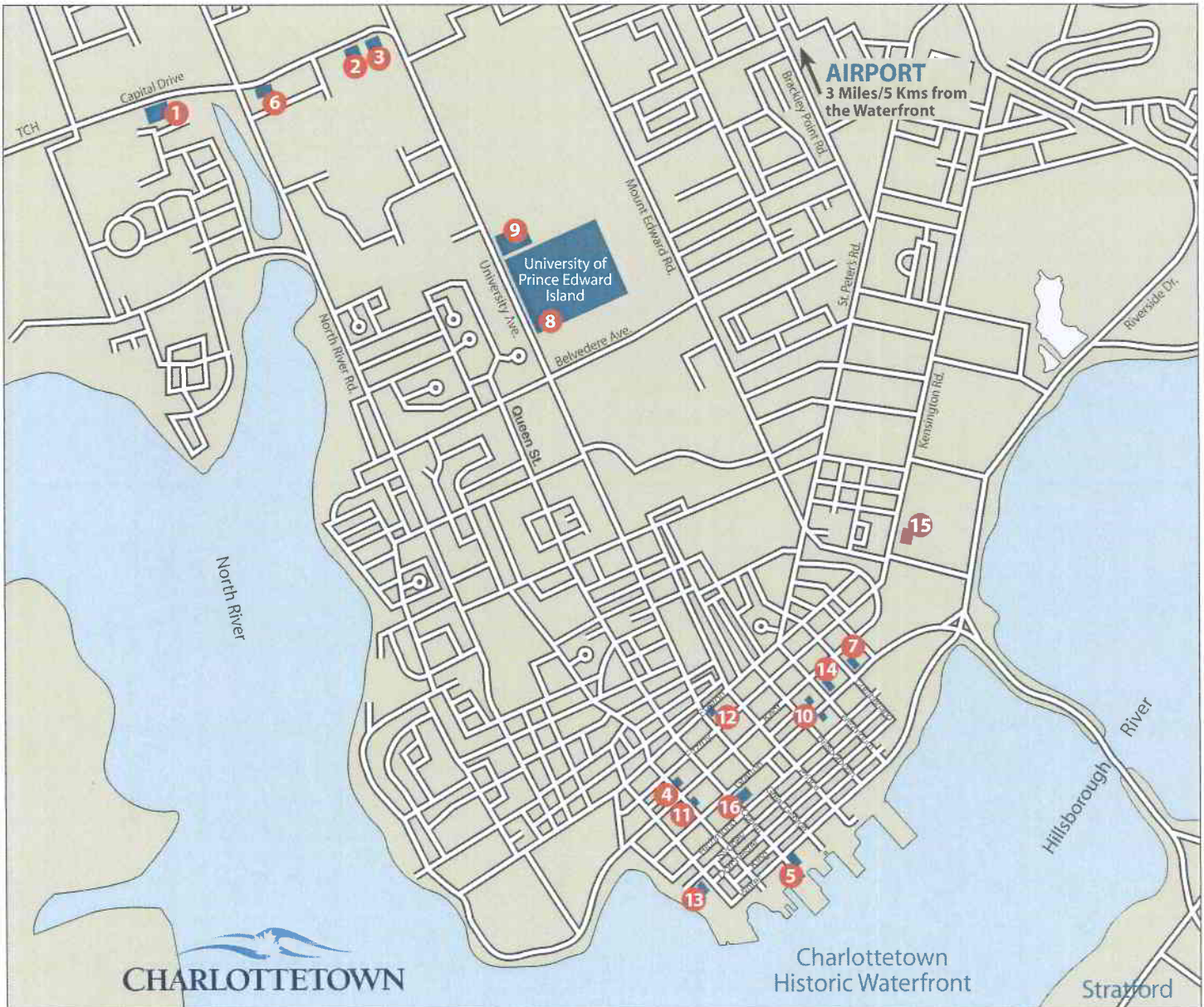
