Teams of 6 students will complete the Trades and Technology Olympics track by participating at hands-on activity stations along the way. The Try-A-Trade style course is constructed so that students complete a variety of tasks associated with Trades and Technology Careers.



The Purpose

Much of this challenge involves testing student's skills in various fields, while getting them to try out a trade or technology in an exciting, hands on way. Students will be exposed to at least eight various trade and technology careers including Engineering, Baking, Mechanics, Technologies, Electrical Wiring, Plumbing, Sewing and Transportation.
